Obsolete June 1, 2021; Type D. Beginning June 1, 2021, new orders for this service will no longer be accepted. Current subscribers may keep their service at its existing location. The Company currently plans to discontinue this service on or after June 1, 2025.

A107.4.1 Definitions and Requirements

A. Access line service for Payphone Service Provider (PSP) telephones is an exchange line service provided at the request of a subscriber for telecommunications use by the general public.

1. This access line service is provided on a flat rate basis in wire centers noted in paragraph A107.4.2. (T) (O)
2. This access line service is provided for use with PSP non-coin-operated public telephones or PSP coin-operated public telephones. (O)
3. PSP telephones may utilize "store and forward" technology to complete 0+ local, intraLATA and interLATA collect-only calls from prisons or jails. All inmate telephones which offer automated collect-only service must be equipped with both an acceptance and rejection response mechanism so if neither action is taken the call is terminated and not billed. (O)
4. The subscriber shall be responsible for the installation, maintenance and operation of PSP telephones used in connection with this service. (O)
5. PSP telephones must be connected to the Company network in compliance with Part 68 of the FCC Rules and Regulations. (O)
6. The service is furnished subject to the condition that all applicable terms and conditions in Section A2.2 will be adhered to, with the exception of A2.2.1 A and B, which restrict the use of service and prohibit payment to the customer by another for use of the service. (O)
7. The service is provided for use by the subscriber but may be used by others when so authorized by the subscriber, provided that all such usage is subject to the provisions of this Guidebook. (O)
8. This service is not subject to concessions. (O)
9. This service may not be suspended at a reduced rate. (O)
10. Access line service for PSP telephones cannot be included on accounts containing other classes of service. A separate account is required for this offering at each location. (O)
11. This access line provides screening information to prevent the operator from allowing toll charges against the subscriber's line. The operator also cannot perform coin collecting functions. (O)
12. The Company is not responsible for refunds of coins deposited in PSP coin-operated telephones. (C) (O)
13. Customer-provided public telephones may only be connected to access line service for PSP telephones. (O)
14. The subscriber to this service will be responsible for any and all toll charges billed to the subscriber's account. (O)
15. Providers of public voice facsimile services which are transmitted over the public switched network are required to obtain Access Line Service for PSP Telephones for connection to the network. The term "Voice Facsimile service" refers to the use of devices providing facsimile service with associated voice capability so that the end user is able to make conventional voice calls as well as electronic transmissions over the same instrument. Provision for such services is subject to the rates, terms and conditions set forth herein for Access Line Service for PSP Telephones. (O)
16. For customers subscribing to Caller ID - Deluxe, as specified in A13.19.5 B., if the incoming call originates from a customer-provided public telephone, the name information transmitted will always be "Pay Phone". (O)

- 2. Service charges are applied on the same basis as for individual line business service covered in Section A 4. (b)
- 3. Non-sent paid local calls will be rated to the end user at the rate of \$.35 per call plus the appropriate operator surcharge in Section A 3. (b)
- 4. Calls completed with automated operator assistance within the extended local calling area for Bridgeport, Phenix City, and Stevenson will be rated at the usage charges as described in A 3.10.3.B. in addition to the appropriate operator assisted local calling surcharges specified in A 3.14. (b)
- 5. The subscriber is responsible for Directory Assistance service charges as specified in Sections A 3. and A 18. (b)
- 6. Trouble determination charges are applied on the same basis as for other Residence or Business Service covered in Section A 4. (b)
- 8. Other rates, terms and conditions in this Guidebook not discussed herein that pertain to Business Standard Measured Service apply. (b)
- 9. Listings in connection with two-way public telephone access lines are furnished as specified in Section A 6. (b)

A107.4.7 Payphone Service Provider Public Inmate Calling Service (PSPICS)

- A. Access line service for PSP telephone service is provided for exclusive use of inmates (hereafter called PSP Inmate Calling Service, or PSPICS) served within the confines of a penal, correctional or mental institution. (b)
- B. Except as modified herein, applicable terms, conditions and requirements as set forth elsewhere in A107.4 for PSP telephones will apply to PSPICS, including availability provided in A107.4.2. (T) (b)
- C. Access line service for PSPICS when provided for the exclusive use of inmates may be concentrated one line to three instruments. However, if more than one instrument occupies a single access line, only one instrument may use the line at a given time. (b)
- D. Dedicated or special access facilities, may be used in addition to the access line in C. preceding for InterLATA and InterLATA calls. (b)
- E. In lieu of Access Line Service as described elsewhere in A107.4, CPE stations subscribing to PSPICS are provisioned by the customer as follows:
 - 1. May be arranged to terminate calls after a certain amount of conversation time, or in cases of emergency in accordance with any Rules and Regulations published and upon notification to the Company of such an arrangement. The Company will not provide credit or equivalent service to the called or calling parties for such calls. (b)
 - 2. May be arranged to block access to certain telephone numbers at the facility administrator's request. (b)
- F. Rates and charges for access line service for PSPICS are provided in A107.4.5. At the request of the facility administrator, blocking of equal access calls (10XXX or 101XXXX) may be provided on telephones for exclusive use of inmates at the rate following.
 - (1) Blocking of equal access call (10XXX or 101XXXX) from completion (b)
