

**1. VIDEO SERVICE**

Additional terms and conditions applicable to Special Access Services may be found in Part 2, Section 2.

**1.1 BASIC CHANNEL DESCRIPTION**

A Video channel is a channel with one-way transmission capability for a standard 525 line/60 field monochrome, or National Television Systems Committee color, video signal and one or more associated audio signal(s) as described below. The provision and the bandwidth of the associated audio signal(s) is a function of the channel interface selected by the customer. Video channels are provided between customer designated premises via a Company Video Hub.

The technical specifications and compatible channel interfaces are set forth in Technical Reference GR-338-CORE. The Company will conform to the transmission specification standards contained in the Technical References for each service. A customer may accept a Video Service that does not conform to transmission specification standards but will not be eligible to receive a Credit Allowance for Service Interruptions as described in Part 2, Section 2 (see 2.3.5.4).

**A. ANALOG VIDEO SERVICE<sup>/1</sup>**

Analog Video Service provides one-way transmission of video signals between two customer-designated premises or between a customer-designated premises and a Company Hub, where available, using fiber optic facilities. An NTSC video channel provides a standard 525 line/60 field monochrome, or NTSC color video signal, with up to four (4) associated 20 kHz audio signals. The bandwidth for Analog Video Service is 30 Hz to 6.6 MHz.

Analog Video Service is provided where facilities are available. Where facilities are not available, Special Construction (see Part 2, Section 5) may apply.

**1. VIDEO SERVICE (cont'd)****1.2 REGULATIONS****A. MINIMUM PERIODS**

The minimum service period for full-time Video Service is one month. The minimum service period for part-time and occasional Video and Program Audio services is one day (i.e., a continuous 24-hour period not limited to a calendar day), even though the service will be provided only for the duration of the event specified on the order (e.g., one-half hour, two hours, five hours, etc.).

**B. SERVICE ORDERING**

The regulations for Ordering Video Service are set forth in Part 2, Section 2, Ordering Options – Access Services. Where rates are not specified in this Guidebook, the rates stated in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 175-T shall apply.

**C. SERVICE CONFIGURATION**

There is one type of service configuration over which Special Access Video Service is provided: two-point service.

**1. Two-Point Service**

A two-point Video service connects two customer- designated premises either directly or through a Company Hub.

**D. BILLING REGULATIONS**

The rules and regulations for billing these Video Services are set forth in Part 2, Section 2.

**1.3 VIDEO HUBS**

The Company will designate certain Hubs for Video Services. Full-time service provided between customer designated premises and a Hub will be billed accordingly at the monthly rates set forth following for a Channel Termination, Optional Features and Functions, and Channel Mileage, as applicable. The rate elements required to provide the part-time or occasional service (i.e., Channel Termination, Optional Features and Functions, and Channel Mileage, as applicable) will be billed at daily rates for the duration of the service requested.
