L1. BASIC ALTERNATIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

GENERAL

This guidebook applies to alternative telecommunications services furnished by BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC, between and among points within the state of Florida pursuant to its status as a certificated Alternative Local Exchange Carrier (ALEC).

This guidebook describes the rules, regulations, descriptions and rates applicable to basic and access services offered by BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC outside its franchised territories in Florida. Specific rules, regulations, descriptions and rates applicable to offerings of this guidebook are incorporated by specific references to the BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC (ILEC) General Exchange Guidebook (Section A) and to the BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC (ILEC) Access Services Tariff (E Tariff).

EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS

When changes are made to any guidebook page, a revised page will be issued; such changes will be identified through the use of the following symbols:

- (C) To signify a changed regulation
- (D) To signify discontinued rate, regulation or text
- (I) To signify increase in rate
- (M) To signify a move from one page to another with no change to text **or** regulation
- (N) To signify new rate and/or new regulation, and/or new text
- (O) To signify obsolesced rate, regulation or text
- (R) To signify reduction in rate
- (T) To signify a change in text but no change in rate or regulation
- (U) To signify USOC added or changed only

PAGE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Page numbers appear in the upper right hand corner of each guidebook page. Pages are numbered sequentially. Point pages may be added, when and if needed. For example, a new page added between page 14 and 15 would be numbered 14.1.

Page revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current pages.

L1. BASIC ALTERNATIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

L1.1 Local Exchange Services

L1.1.1 General

A. Alternative local telecommunications services offered by BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC, are offered and provided in the same way, subject to the same terms and conditions, at the same rates and subject to the same charges as are local exchange services described in the General Exchange Guidebook Sections A2 and A3.

L1.1.2 Exchange Service List

A. BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC, will provide alternative local telecommunications services in portions of the following exchange service areas, where facilities permit. Rates for each affected exchange are applicable on a rate group specific basis. The rate group assignment for each affected exchange is listed in the following table. Rates for the designated rate groups are as detailed in the General Exchange Guidebook, Section A3, and are incorporated herein by reference.
