

OPTIONAL LONG DISTANCE CALLING PLANS**A. Descriptive Summary**

This Section applies to the Optional Offerings of Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service called 1+SAVER® Plans. These outward calling plans are for intraLATA services which allow subscribing customers to place intraLATA long distance calls for a discount.

B. General Regulations

The Optional Long Distance Calling Plans are furnished under General Regulations as set forth in this Part. In addition, the following regulations apply:

1. Service is furnished subject to the availability of the telecommunications facilities required.
2. Rates for these plans apply only to intrastate intraLATA messages.

For Kansas Connection and Optional Community Calling Service, only customer dialed station-to-station sent paid non-coin messages apply.

3. The 1+SAVER® Plan is not offered in connection with Foreign Exchange (FX), Foreign Serving Office (FSO) or Payphone Exchange Access Service.
4. This service is offered to hotel/motel customers, interexchange carriers, intraexchange carriers and reseller customers for administrative trunks only. Local exchange carriers and/or subsidiaries of local exchange carriers receiving compensation under the designated carrier arrangement or similar plan may not use 1+SAVER in conjunction with call forwarding or similar services for the purpose of offering or providing internet access to their end-user customer.
5. Optional Calling Plan service shall not be used for any purpose for which a payment or other compensation shall be received by either the customer or user in the collection, transmission, or delivery of any communications for others.
6. The residence options of 1+SAVER are available to residential customers subscribing to Kansas Connection and/or Optional Community Calling Service. If applicable, billing will occur in the following order:
 - a. 2 Kansas Connection
 - b. Optional Community Calling Service
 - c. 1+SAVER

7. The business options of 1+SAVER are available to business customers subscribing to Optional Community Calling Service. If applicable, billing will occur in the following order:
 - a. Optional Community Calling Service
 - b. 1+SAVER
8. 1+SAVER customers may only subscribe to one 1+SAVER option per account.
9. The minimum contract period for Optional Calling Plans is 30 days.
10. The 1+SAVER Option 5 of the Residence Plan and Options 4 and 5^{/1} of the Business Plan apply to calls originated in Company exchanges only.
11. The 1+SAVER Option 4 of the Business Plan is available only to business customers subscribing to BizSaver as set forth in the Custom Calling Services in Part 7. (C)
12. Application of Rates and Charges - 1+SAVER
 - a. After a subscriber's monthly intraLATA long distance bill is determined, including applicable time of day discounts, an additional percent discount will be applied to the total qualified portion of the bill. When application of the discount results in a fractional charge, the amount will be rounded to the lower cent.
 - b. Discounts apply to usage accumulated from all lines on a customer's account.
13. Timing of Messages

The timing of messages is as specified in Part 9, Section 1, except that timing of messages will be in whole minutes with fractions counted as whole minutes.

C. Time of Day Discount Period

(C)

The time when connection is established determines whether Day rates apply. The time is determined in accordance with the time--standard or daylight saving--legally or commonly in use at the location of the switching office of the calling service point. The time (at the calling service point) at which connection is established governs.

OPTIONAL COMMUNITY CALLING SERVICE

A. Service Description

Optional Community Calling Service (Community Calling) allows subscribers to make 1+ customer-dialed station-to-station calls from their exchange to one or more designated exchanges or zones of exchanges, as specified in D. following, under rates different than those Two-Point Service in Section 1 of this Part.

B. Regulations

1. Community Calling is offered to all classes and grades of residence and business customers located in the exchanges specified in paragraph D. following.
2. Community Calling is not offered in connection with Foreign Exchange (FX) Service, Foreign Serving Office (FSO) Service or Payphone Exchange Access Service.
3. This service is offered to hotel/motel customers for administrative trunks only. Local exchange carriers and/or subsidiaries of local exchange carriers receiving compensation under the designated carrier arrangement or similar settlement plan may not use Community Calling in conjunction with call forwarding or similar services for the purpose of offering or providing internet access to their end-user customer.
4. This service applies on a per-line basis to all exchange access lines that are group billed.
5. The minimum contract period for this service is 30 days.
6. See paragraph 3.5 for applicable nonrecurring charges.
7. The Community Calling Initial Period Charge described following, applies to each exchange access line on a per-line basis in addition to the local exchange service rates as specified in Part 4 Section 2.
8. Usage billed under Community Calling will not be further discounted by any option of the 1+SAVER® Optional Long Distance Calling Plan.
9. The rates for Community Calling apply only to 1+ customer-dialed station-to-station messages. For all other classes of messages, the appropriate rates and charges specified elsewhere in the Part 9 and Part 11 apply.

C. Measured Usage Payment Elements and Billing

1. Optional Community Calling Service consists of three rate elements:
 - a. the Community Calling Initial Usage Period which is a specified quantity of hours of 1+ customer-dialed station-to-station calling to the exchange(s) specified in paragraph D.2 following. Three Initial Usage Period plans are available as described in D.1 following;
 - b. the Community Calling Initial Period Charge which is applied on a per line basis each month to each line group-billed allowing the subscriber to make that quantity of hours of 1+ customer-dialed station-to-station calling defined to be the Initial Usage Period for that

C. Measured Usage Payment Elements and Billing (cont'd)

1. Optional Community Calling Service consists of three rate elements: (cont'd)
 - c. the Community Calling Additional Usage Charge which is calculated by applying the Community Calling Additional Usage Charge Rate to each minute of 1+ customer-dialed station-to-station calling in excess of the Initial Usage Period.
2. Community Calling usage is billed in arrears on a bulk basis only.
3. Fractional minutes of calling are rounded to the next whole minute on each message.
4. For each exchange access line group billed, the Initial Usage Period applicable to each line is accumulated for all lines and subtracted from the accumulated usage for all lines. The Community Calling Additional Usage Charge rate applies to this difference, if any.
5. Customers in exchanges qualifying for Optional Community Calling Service to two or more exchanges will get all exchanges to which they qualify at no additional charge.

OPTIONAL COMMUNITY CALLING SERVICE (cont'd)**E. Nonrecurring Charges**

1. The charges shown below apply on a per access line basis when a customer adds Community Calling or changes from one Usage Payment Option to the other:

<u>Nonrecurring Charges</u>	
Business	\$10.00
Residence	8.75

2. In cases where a customer subscribes to any combination of Kansas Connection, Optional Community Calling Service, 1+SAVER®, or 1+SAVER Direct® at the same time, only the highest applicable service charge will apply.
3. The first six (6) months that Community Calling is available in an exchange will be considered a promotional period for the service during which the nonrecurring charges specified above may be waived as follows:
 - a. During the promotional period any eligible business or residence customer may add Community Calling at no charge.
 - b. That same customer will then be allowed two (2) additional Community Calling service order transactions during the promotional period at no charge.
 - c. Any additional Community Calling service order transactions initiated by the customer, beyond the initial and two others as specified above will be subject to the nonrecurring charges specified in paragraph 1 preceding, even if the promotional period has not yet elapsed. When the promotional period does elapse, however, the nonrecurring charges above apply to all Community Calling additions or changes initiated by any business or residence customer whether he/she has used any, all, or none of the service order transactions that would have been eligible for waiver during the promotional period.
