## 1.1.6. RATE TABLES

Within Guidebook rate tables three types of entries are allowed:

- Rate amount
- NO
- RR

1. The rate amount indicates the dollar value associated with the service.
2. The NO indicates there is no rate for the service or a rate amount is not applicable under the specific column header.
3. The RR indicates that the rate and/or charge is reference rated to an existing rate and/or charge. A note must be shown next to the USOC or description to explain where the referenced rate and/or charge is found.

## 1.1.7. USOC COLUMN

Within Guidebook USOC columns two types of entries are allowed:

- USOC code
- NA

1. The USOC code consist of either three or five characters.
2. The NA which indicates there is no applicable USOC.
