2.4 ACOUSTIC, INDUCTIVE CONNECTIONS

Where at the request of the Carrier for resale to its customer, the network protection criteria as specified in Part 2, Section 9, of this tariff are to be used at a specified location in connection with customer-provided data terminal equipment, a non-recurring charge identical to the Maintenance of Service Charge specified in Part 22, Section 2, applies to each WATS access line which requires a visit to the Carrier's Customer's premises by Telephone Company personnel to specify the level of signal power or to provide any conditioning required on the access line. The non-recurring charge does not apply if this work is performed at the same time the WATS access line is installed.

2.5 MAINTENANCE OF SERVICE CHARGE DUE TO CUSTOMER-PROVIDED EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES OR COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS PROVIDED BY OCC'S

Charges for visits of Telephone Company personnel to Carrier's Customer's premises where a service difficulty or trouble report results from customer-provided equipment or communications systems or communications systems provided by OCC's are set forth in Part 22, Section 2, of this tariff.

2.6 SUPPLEMENTAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES

Directory listings may be furnished with 800 Service at the applicable rates for business additional listings as covered in Part 22, Section 12, of this tariff.

2.7 FOUR-WIRE TRUNK TERMINATION

In addition to the Access Line Charge for a Two-wire termination set forth in this tariff, the following charge applies to Four-wire terminations.
